


Install the Adapter


- Use an optical or RCA cable (not included) to connect your digital source to the audio adapter.
- 2. Select the digital input (OPT or COAX).
- **3.** Connect the audio adapter to your stereo system with a stereo RCA cable.
- 4. Connect the supplied AC adapter.

Note: This adapter accepts 2-channel digital audio only, and works with any PCM stream with Dolby Digital or DTS disabled. Dolby Digital and other multichannel compressed audio formats are not compatible.
