

Keys for Fascia Callout

- 1) Callout of fascia description in the Parts Tracker & Item Master will be done similar to what a VIN number on a vehicle would be, where every character position has a purpose.
- 2) There are a total of 30 characters available to describe an item, however, we will only be using 28 of these characters for now. If there are no alphabetical or numerical characters used in a given position, use a dash in its place.
- 3) The remaining two characters are to remain blank for now and will not require a dash to be used.

KIT: must use 3 characters [1 thru 3]; use ONLY one of these definitions

- KIT = complete kit for specified model and floorplan

FASCIA: must use 6 characters [4 thru 9]

- FASCIA = Fascia kit for specified model and floorplan

BRAND: must use 2 characters [10 & 11]; use ONLY one of these definitions

- BT = Baystar Sport Class A
- BS = Baystar Class A
- B- = Baystar Sport Class A & Baystar Class A
- CS = Canyon Star Front Diesel
- SS = Super Sport Super C
- KS = Kountry Star Diesel Pusher
- VT = Ventana Diesel Pusher
- DS = Dutch Star Diesel Pusher
- NA = New Air Diesel Pusher
- SA = Supreme Air Super C
- MA = Mountain Aire Diesel Pusher
- LA = London Aire Diesel Pusher
- EX = Essex Diesel Pusher
- KG = King Aire Diesel Bus

MODEL NUMBER: must use 4 character [12 thru 15]

- Use the four digit floor plan here

WOOD SPECIES: must use 3 characters [16 thru 18]; use ONLY one of these definitions

- MPL = Maple

- CHY = Cherry
- OAK = Oak
- CMP = Composite

RECEIVED FINISH: must use 3 characters [19 thru 21]; use ONLY one of these definitions

- RAW = Raw unfinished wood
- FIN = Vendor Finished part (Purchasing to communicate with vendor the finish color)

OPTION INFORMATION: must use 4 characters [22 thru 25]; use ONLY one of these definitions

- STND = Standard Fascia
- K650 = This is just one sample of an option number to be used to spell out any differences in the fascia

DÉCOR NUMBER (OPTIONAL): If the brand of product requires the fascia to come in with a décor specific portion installed by the vendor, you can use characters 26 thru 28 to identify the décor number.

- Blank = If this décor number is not needed, these three character fields can remain blank. No dashes needed.
- 351 = This would be the décor number for the 2021 KSDP since this particular fascia will come from the vendor with the fabric portion already installed by vendor. Vendor needs to know which fabric to use when the actual fascia is ordered.

REVISIONS: characters (29 & 30) are used to identify revisions on the fascia. If a revision is made to the fascia and you need to add a revision identifier to the new part that you are creating, you must make sure that the three spaces reserved for the Décor number are occupied with either a décor number or three dashes. DO NOT LEAVE THE DÉCOR NUMBER SPOTS (numbers 26 thru 28) EMPTY AND ADD A REVISION.

- Blank = If no revision is needed, these two places can remain blank. No dashes are needed.
- -A = First revision
- -B = Second revision
