As you know, we are quickly approaching the winter weather season which means snow, ice and more importantly, road salt for those of you traveling in such climates. We at Spartan Chassis wish to insure the superior experience you have enjoyed with our product this summer extends through the winter and beyond.

One step we wish you would take to preserve the performance and function of your vehicle brake system is to inspect the Haldex brake chambers for the presence and proper installation of the dust plugs. Dislodged or missing dust plugs can lead to corrosion in these chambers when exposed to road surface traction treatments such as road salt.

Should you need to purchase replacement dust plugs you should contact your preferred service center (request part # RPT 1) or contact Spartan Chassis at 800-722-3025 for the service center nearest you.
