DESCRIPTION OF PROBLEM																	
<p>Frigidaire has released technical service information regarding the use of their freestanding refrigerators in ambient temperatures over 110 degrees. Potential failure exists if the unit is used under these conditions.</p>																	
RECOMMENDED SOLUTION																	
<p>Frigidaire recommends NOT operating the unit if the ambient air temp is 110 degrees or higher. Read the attached information from Frigidaire regarding this condition. Please contact your Newmar Technical Service Representative if you have further questions.</p>

## **Frigidaire Product Bulletin**

By design, the freestanding Frigidaire refrigerator (residential style) will not operate properly when indoor air temperatures exceed 110°F (43°C). In addition, operating the refrigerator in these conditions could cause compressor failure which may not be considered warrantable.

Please educate your Sales & Service staff as well as your retail customers of this situation and we would recommend these options:

- Leave the air conditioner set on 80°F or lower if the refrigerator is left running in a vehicle that is not being used.
- If the inside temperature of the vehicle cannot be kept below 110°F (43°C), the refrigerator must be shut off.
