OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

SHADES SHOULD BE OPENED OR CLOSED BY PUSHING THE BOTTOM RAIL UP OR PULLING DOWN WITH THE KNOBS PROVIDED. FOR A DUPLEX (DAY/NIGHT) SHADE OR FREE-FLOATING SHADE, MOVE ONLY ONE RAIL AT A TIME. SHADES SHOULD REMAIN UP WHEN NOT IN USE TO AID IN PLEAT RETENTION. IF TENSION ADJUSTMENTS BECOME NECESSARY, SIMPLY WIND CORDS AROUND CENTER OF THE BOBBIN FASTENER TO TIGHTEN, OR RE-TIE TO LOOSEN. ANY ADJUSTMENTS SHOULD BE MADE EQUALLY ON BOTH CORDS FOR SHADE TO REMAIN LEVEL. RUBBING CORDS WITH PARAFIN WAX (OR CANDLE) WILL HELP TO LENGTHEN THE LIFE OF THE CORDS BY REDUCING FRICTION/FRAYING.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

DRY BRUSH OR VACUUM ONLY. PLEATED SHADES SHOULD NOT GET WET. USE A DAMP CLOTH WITH MILD SOAP TO REMOVE SMALL SPOTS.
