
Subject: The Elimination of the "Eco-Valve" in all Fuel-Nozzles.

* This Technical Bulletin applies to all Aqua-Hot, Hydro-Hot, and Webasto DBW 2010 Heaters.

This Technical Bulletin addresses the <u>complete elimination</u> of the "Eco-Valve", from all Fuel-Nozzles, that are utilized in the Aqua-Hot, Hydro-Hot, and Webasto DBW 2010 Hydronic Heating Systems.

Vehicle Systems, Inc. has recently determined that the need for the "Eco-Valve" is no longer necessary. The Eco-Valve is an integral part of the Diesel-Burner's <u>Fuel-Nozzle (part # WPE-886-41V)</u> and is designed to instantly shut-off the flow of diesel fuel to the Diesel-Burner, once the internal Solenoid-Valve has been electrically deactivated. We have determined that this valve adds no benefit to any of our RV Hydronic Heating Systems; due to the discovery that our current combustion chamber temperatures automatically burn-off any residual diesel fuel that may be left behind once the Solenoid-Valve closes. This Eco-Valve was initially designed for Residential applications where Boilers typically operate at lower temperatures and thus may require the need for such a product.

Therefore, from this date forth all of our new production Diesel-Burners (i.e. RV Hydronic Heating Systems) will be supplied <u>without</u> the Eco-Valve, as well as all replacement Fuel-Nozzles (new part # WPX-886-41A). If your company presently stocks any existing Fuel-Nozzles, (old part # WPE-886-41V) with Eco-Valves, please contact our Service Department at 1-800-685-4298 for replacement Rock-Filters, see Figure below for details.
