PROBLEM: On Newmar MM chassis with MH 3000 transmissions the fluid level reads 3 quarts low on the touch pad, while the dipstick reads full.

Please Read the Entire Tech Tip Before Proceeding With Any Work.

Verify The Complaint:

Ensure this is a Newmar MM chassis with a MH 3000 Allison Transmission with SO # between 43160 and 47790 (VDM Between 2-10-03 and 3-11-04) using dipstick part numbers 0352-TT2-010 or 0352-TT2-010T with dipstick tube part number 0442-TT2-001.

Problem Identification:

The touch pad will indicate transmission fluid level is 3 quarts low, but the transmission dipstick will indicate that the fluid level is full.

Problem Correction:

- Remove the existing transmission dipstick from the dipstick tube and discard.
- Replace the transmission dipstick with p/n 0473-TT2-001 (Dipstick only).
