DESCRIPTION OF PROBLEM																							
Possible condensation builds up in microwave cabinet when microwave is used for a long period of time.																							
RECOMMENDED SOLUTION																							
Add vent per attached print. This can cause cold air to come in unit by adding vent. This is not covered under Newmar warranty, but is a solution if your customer wants to add a vent for the microwave.

Though NOT required by the manufacture of the microwave, additional venting for the built in 22" microwave can be achieved by removing the microwave and installing a vent through to the exterior of the unit. This vent could be similar to the range vent. When locating this vent on the sidewall be sure to locate the sidewall studs first in order to assure that you do not cut through the studs. The vent must be located between the sidewall studs. The top of the vent should be approximately even with the top of the microwave opening.

NOTE: This may cause cold air to enter the unit in cold weather.
